3 & 4 year old grant: Ealing Council annouced later part of last year that the Government have assessed Ealing to be classified as NOT high need borough, in terms of volumne of deprivation and families in need. In order to support other London boroughs that have greater need for vulnerable children and families, Ealing's hourly rate for the grant will be reduced, currently we receive £4.64 per hour, however, this will be lower from the new finanical year. As a service this will mean, Consumable charge amount will change!

Take Home Meals

As requested by some parents, we can now provide take away meals (Cooked by Mr. Baz \bigcirc) for the children, if you would like this service please inform a practitioner and provide a container. The charge is £2 per meal which can be added to monthly invoices.
